This is an intermediate level course which covers balancing speed and accuracy, immediate reactive skills, proficiency in dealing with malfunctions, multiple threats engagement at speed, long distance shooting at speed and low level light shooting techniques.

Subjects Covered:

- Review of existing skills
- Proper care and maintenance of the pistol
- How to set up the pistol for maximum efficiency
- Man on man timed drills
- Multiple target engagement at speed
- Varied distance shooting
- Night time shooting techniques – level 1
- Malfunction drills
- Speed reloading
- Failure drills at speed

Equipment: Cleaned and oiled pistol at least 9mm in caliber, at least two magazines, sturdy nylon or leather belt or duty rig, holster and mag pouch, eye and ear protection, sturdy flashlight with spare batteries (preferably Surefire), 500 rounds factory ammo

Prerequisites: ITTS Carbine Level I or equivalent from an ITTS recognized school (proof of completion required)

He also spent several years as an adjunct instructor for the Department of Energy’s SRT-III training in New Mexico. Scott is a use of deadly force expert witness in police defense cases for the Superior and Federal Courts and works as a lecturer and consultant on high profile cases for law firms, the District Attorney’s office and the U.S. Government. He is the head firearms instructor for International Tactical Training Seminars, Inc. (I.T.T.S.), a private firearms school in Los Angeles.
